



Open Age's **Adult Community Learning (ACL)** offers a number of courses. These courses **need to be booked** and require a commitment which range between 5 and 10 weeks depending on the course. These classes are different from the standard Open Age drop in classes. You **must** be able to comply with the conditions listed below:

- To complete an enrolment form which entails providing evidence of ID i.e. Passport or Driving Licence and National Insurance number.
- We need one completed enrolment for each academic year (September 2023 to July 2024)
- Commitment to attend all sessions

#### **ACL Costs:**

Our ACL courses are a slightly different cost to all the other Open Age classes as we are funded by the government via the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea. Our fees are **£3 per session**. However the course may be free if you meet the eligibility criteria.
