### IT for Beginners.

## Start dates: 1) 16 September and 2) 28 October STM/tbc/ PRO-tbc

For customers with little or no computer experience who wish to build up skills to use computers for everyday life in the digital world. The course includes practical training in Word (word processing), Excel (spreadsheets), managing a diary using the Outlook Calendar, use of mobile devices, using the internet, emailing and computer basics including file management. The skills can be used for job search and job applications and to update CVs as well as using the 'Find a Job' site.

Qualification: City & Guilds Entry Level 3 Certificate in Start IT. Duration: 12 days, 10:00–15:30 hrs

## Introduction to Self-Employment and Working from Home

## Start dates: 1) 07 August, 2) 11 September and 3) 09 October STM/tbc/ PRO-tbc

This course offers an opportunity for learners to find out more about using entrepreneurial skills to find work through the internet, in the so-called 'gig economy' (e.g. Ebay, Task Rabbit, Etsy). It will allow you to look at your current skills, including those gained through hobbies and see how these can be used to earn an income or additional income. Content includes: The modern world of remote working; Brand You; Profile writing and getting customers; Building a long term career. Examples of work available includes: office work/admin, customer service, translating, gardening, pet care any kind of handy person work. Qualifications: SFEDI Level 1 Certificate in Gateway to Independent and Remote Working. Duration: 6 days, 10:00-15:30hrs.

#### **Social Media for Business Use**

This course includes effective use of Social Media, such as LinkedIn, Facebook, Twitter and much more, to build professional networks and promote skills to find work. It covers: how to use social media to engage with an audience, how to set up social media for business use, create and maintain content to publish for business use.

Eligibility: The classroom courses are for unemployed or people on a low wage who are aged 19+ and have lived in the UK/EU for the last three years. To enrol participants will need to provide photo ID, ie Passport/EU ID card, or birth certificate /Home Office documents and National Insurance number and proof of state benefits such as of JSA, SA, Income Support, Universal Credit. NB CPD qualifications are available free of charge to people who are unemployed or employed as long as the courses are taken independently of the employer. ESF programmes are for those aged between 16-24.
