We will be offering talks and taster sessions, as well as game afternoons. This group aims to reach out the most isolated adults over the age of 50 living in Hans Town and Brompton Ward. The group will be running initially during 40 weeks starting 24th April and ending on 26th February 2019 with breaks during three weeks in August and two weeks in December.

Your role will be to support the group facilitator and to help with preparing tea and coffee. Setting up the room in an attractive way and to provide a friendly welcome the members of the group and assisting in any inquiries they may have about our activity. Assisting the facilitator in serving refreshments and cakes to the members, as well as tidying the room at the end of the day ensuring that everything is put away correctly and switched off. Socialising with Open Age members, for example playing board games or having a cup of tea and a biscuits.

We're looking for a friendly, empathic and reliable person who has a passion for working with the public, particularly the older generation.

Hours are Tuesdays (except during break) between 13.30-16.30. Travel expenses can be reimbursed up to £4.50 per day. DBS certificate is needed—we can assist you with completing this.
