Hello Carers, welcome to your Autumn programme. What a fabulous Summer we've had. Thank you for joining in. Here are some great trips and events planned for the next three months. Hopefully you can join us, try new things and have some fun. To book a space call **Reception** on **020 8962 4141** ask for Ashley's TFM Chelsea trips. All activities must be booked in advance, but to keep things fair please book only 5 activities at once. Please note these activities are for unpaid carers, over 50 and living in South Kensington and Chelsea. You must be a member of Open Age or New Horizons; membership is free.

The Porchester Spa - *Thursday 4th October & *Thursday 8th November - Come and enjoy a sauna and steam, and let your troubles drift away. Sorry guy's this one is for ladies only. We will meet at the Porchester Spa at 10.15am. Must Book! There are 8 free day passes available.

Thursday 11th October - Hannah Perry "GUSH" at Somerset House. This British artist and Somerset House Studios resident presents a major body of new work in her first solo exhibition in the UK since 2015.GUSH presents a captivating and poignant exhibition featuring large-scale dynamic sculpture, sound and film, in a candid and personal exploration of mental and emotional health in our contemporary, hyper-networked society. **We will meet at Somerset House at 1pm. There are 7 spaces available.**

Friday 19th October - Archibald Ziegler: A Working Artist. Following his sudden death in 1971 aged 68, this is the first retrospective of Archibald Ziegler's work in London in four decades. A working class artist who was orphaned at 14, he has been largely overlooked despite winning great acclaim early in his career. **We will meet at Hampstead Underground Station at 12.30pm. There are 7 spaces available.**

Friday's 26th October, 2nd, 9th and 16th November - My Nature Watch Course (4 wk course). In this four-part course, learn how to make the My Naturewatch Camera, as featured recently on BBC Springwatch. You will also learn about local wildlife through a guided walk of Holland Park & surrounding area. Please note that you need to bring a smartphone be able to commit to all four sessions and will get to keep the My Naturewatch camera at the end of the course. Each session is from 11am to 1pm. Must Book! We will meet at the Design Museum at 10.45am. There are 5 spaces available.

WEDNESDAY 31st October - Connaught Opera for Carers. From the wonderful setting of Leighton House Museum in Holland Park, Maria Arakie, Glenn Wilson & Pianist Nick Bosworth present a special event for carers preforming live "The Fabulous 50s" **Meet at Leighton House Museum at 6.15pm for a pre event drink. Thursday 1st November - Walks of Art No. Taken from the TATE Walks of Art Guide, this self guided walking tour around Kensington & Hyde Park explores public art exhibits along the way, includes Francis Bacon, Jacob Epstein and Ian Hamilton Finlay We will meet in Parliament Square at 11am. Thursday 15th November - Raptor Foundation At the Raptor Foundations, they rescue, rehabilitate and return injured birds of prey back to the wild and also protect and preserve them through education and conservation. At this visit we will see the important work that they do, see a flying display and have a bite to eat at the Silent Wings Café. There are two coach pick up points for this trip. Pick up 1 is from the corner of Sloane Street and Cadogan Gate at 10.30am. Pick up 2 from St Charles Centre for Health & Wellbeing at 11am, There are 15 spaces available for this full day trip.
